

SFVYC TRANSBAY RACE: JUNE 19, 2010

Seven boats, including a new member of our club, Jack Rose sailing his newly-purchased J-35, Privateer, entered the 16.2 nautical mile Trans Bay Race. At the skippers' meeting the rabbit start was explained: The start would be at the "H" mark, perhaps a bit early or late. At the start, Turn Key the rabbit, crossed the "H" mark a minute early, causing a few problems for itself and some of the others.

After a beat to "DD", the weather mark, they sailed a broad reach to the El Segundo Buoy (2ES). Chris Brorsen on Taku flew his beautiful new spinnaker, making time on most of the others. After rounding 2ES, Turn Key headed northwest toward the MDR "S" mark, but failed to leave it to starboard, and turned back after a mile to correct the error. Windschiff and Taku also failed to round "S" but continued, and are separately scored. Together with Turn Key and the others they rounded the SM1 buoy off of Santa Monica, and returned to the "SS" mark at Marina del Rey. The boats, including Might as Well in First place and Never 2 Late in Second then entered the south entrance of the marina, finishing at a yellow channel marker in the harbor.

With the wind between 10 and 14 knots, Turn Key averaged 6.4 knots. The great wind and fairly flat seas provided a good time for everyone. After the race the sailors gathered at the South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club for refreshments and discussion.

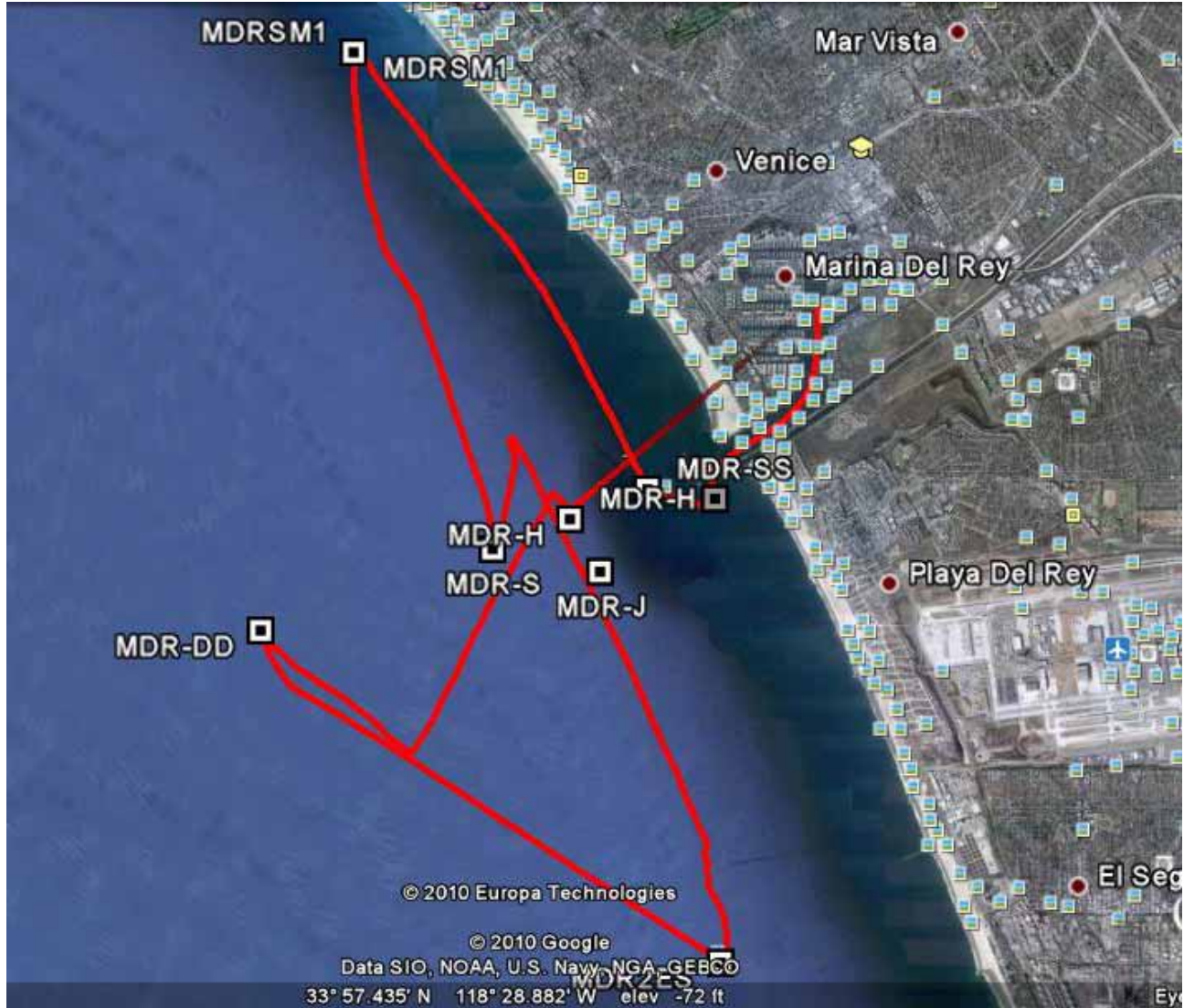
